President Paul Koba called the LVSOA meeting to order at 7:30

- 1 Adam Smeltz explained the chapter officials ballot for playoff's
- 2 Meeting minutes of the September 19, 2010 were read and approved.
- 3 Treasurers Report: \$6193.36. Ned Strong First Bill Danish Second
- 4 Interpretations: Adam Smeltz
 - a. The game suspension procedure was explained. If the game is suspended in the first half the game will be restarted from the point of suspension. This should be noted in the official score book. If the game is suspended at the half or in the second half and there is a team winning at this point, it is an official game. If the game is tied at the half or in the second half there are two options. If both teams agree the game can end as a tie. If the teams do not agree the game will be continued from the point of suspension.
 - b. No one is allowed to move the corner flags for the purpose of making an easier corner kick.
 - c. Ball boys may be behind the goals as long as they are not interfering with play. If they are interfering they must be removed.
 - d. 5 minute sit out on all yellow cards. The carded player may not report to the table until the 5 minutes have expired.
 - e. Players may not wear head ware that has a knot in it.
