

PIAA Meeting Minutes

Sunday October 9, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 by President Paul Koba. There were 82 members in attendance.

Minutes of the previous meeting - Dave Steiner

There were no minutes taken at the October third and fifth meetings. There was no business conducted because there was not a quorum present.

Minutes of the meeting of September 25 were read, Motion to approve. The minutes were approved.

Interpretations:

If there is a drop ball in the penalty area and the keeper Takes it and drops on it, call dangerous play and give the ball to the other team.

You must have two players, one from each team, for a drop ball.

If there are no coaches boxes marked and the coach is a problem, get some cones and mark the area with them.

Noisemakers are allowed during the run of play, unless they are obviously interfering with play.

If lightning / thunder occurs, no one is allowed on the field for thirty minutes. This means for warm-ups not the restart of play.

Sleeve ties are not legal.

Jewelry is not legal and must come off or the player may not participate. The exception is medic alert jewelry and it must be taped to the body with the information exposed.

A deflection off of a defender does not now put an offside player onside. The ball must be played for this to happen.

A player in High school must deliberately kicks the ball to the keeper for a violation to occur. A defender stepping on the ball and the keeper picking it up is legal, unless the official feels there was trickery involved.

When attempting a PK the player miss kicks the ball and it deflects off the goal and a teammate of his runs into the area and puts the ball into the goal. This is a good goal.

PIAA wants officials to use the signals when making calls. The partner / partners are to mirror the calling official.
